SMS goes on CSR drive this Republic Day

Earlier, unfurling the tri-colour on the occasion of the country's 61st Republic Day, the Director Prof. P. N. He said, if we together understand our responsibilities and deliver our services accordingly; our society would get rid of the human built disparity that impedes nation building. In the light of the event, he said that nation should come first above all.
