SMS VARANASI ORGANISES ONLINE TEST SMART-2014

School of Management Sciences (SMS), Varanasi on Sunday, 19th October, 2014 organised an Online aptitude test named SMS Mental Ability Recognition Test (SMART) for the intermediate students to identify the potential talent existing in the city, with an intention to hone their skills depending on the aptitude of the candidate. 500 students from 22 schools of Varanasi and adjacent areas of Purvanchal participated in the event. The prominent schools included St. John's School (DLW, Madauli and Ledhupur), DAV Public School, DPS Kashi, DLW Inter college, Gtenuhill Public School, Little Flower House, CHS (Boys and Girls), Aditya Birla Public School, Renukoot etc. to name a few.
